Oceanic Research Group, Inc. is offering a \$1000 scholarship for deserving students pursuing marine-related undergraduate or graduate studies. Oceanic Research Group is a volunteer, 501 (c)(3) nonprofit, environmental organization based in North Reading, MA. Its mission is to promote the conservation of the marine environment through education.

The scholarship is open to undergraduate students entering the junior or senior year or graduate students with an overall GPA of at least 3.0/4.0 and demonstrated financial need. Students must be United States citizens and enrolled or accepted in an accredited United States college or university beginning with the 2010 fall term.

The application deadline is October 1, 2010. It will be available on the Oceanic Research Group website at: <http://www.oceanicresearch.org/scholarship.htm> . You can submit your application electronically if you have a version of Adobe Acrobat that allows interactive PDFs to be saved. Otherwise, you will need to print out the application and scan it to email the file or mail it to the address at the end of the application.

The scholarship will be awarded at the Oceanic Research Group Benefit on Friday November 5, 2010.
